



## The 2<sup>nd</sup> Joint Coordination Committee (JCC) Meeting for the ANZEN – SATREPS project held in Nay Pyi Taw, Myanmar

The second Joint Coordination Committee (JCC) Meeting for the Project for the Development of a Comprehensive Disaster Resilience System and Collaboration Platform in Myanmar (ANZEN-SATREPS project) was held on the 13<sup>th</sup> of September 2016 at Grand Amara Hotel in Nay Pyi Taw, the capital city of Myanmar. Total of 59 participants from the Ministry of Education, JICA, JCC members from various governmental agencies and organizations in Myanmar as well as working group members of Yangon Technological University and researchers from Japan have attended the meeting and actively engaged themselves in the discussion. Project progress since the last JCC Meeting a year ago was reported by the leaders of six research groups and the project activities and plan for the next phase according to the Project Design Matrix (PDM) were reviewed. Topics in the general discussion included addition of two concerned departments to the JCC member namely Department of Hydropower Implementation (DHPI) and Post and Telecom Department (PTD), issues and arrangement to promote active student participation and measures for proper operation and maintenance of the donated equipment from Japan.
